

Family Clay Sunday

Bring the kids, bring the parents, bring the grandparents for some quality together time and learn to create with stoneware clay. Ages range from 2 to 96 and everyone has a blast in our teaching studio. This family-based community gathering runs through most of the school year. Drop in any time between 1:00 PM and 4:00 PM on Sundays. \$10 for up to 4 in a family. \$3 for each extra person.

<i>January 6</i>	Snow people, snow houses — Create snow creatures like the “Abominable Snowman” and “The Thing,” out of clay, or whatever represents winter to you.
<i>January 13</i>	Mascots — Make a facsimile of the Oregon university mascot you most favor – either a duck or a beaver. You’ll combine pinch bowls and clay slabs to make these iconic figures.
<i>January 20</i>	Bobble heads — Make bobbing monster or alien heads on a coil-made base for your room that will detect such things as earthquakes and invading parents.
<i>January 27</i>	Valentine boxes or dishes — Get a jump on Valentine’s Day with lidded boxes or heart shaped dishes to keep, or fill and give as presents.
<i>February 3</i>	Flower vase or hand bowl — Make water tight coil vases to fill with flowers or make an outline of your hand to form a handy bowl.
<i>February 11</i>	Tiny bird houses or nests — Song birds will soon be returning. Welcome them with a tiny bird house or nest with birds, eggs, or chicks.
<i>February 17</i>	Jewelry holder or animal bowl — Create a cool jewelry and earring holder or a 4-legged animal bowl for ice cream. Pinch pots and coils make up these projects.
<i>February 24</i>	Slab Sculpture — Create a whimsical sculpture using slab, pinching and sculpting skills which will be fun to make and look at when finished.
<i>March 3</i>	Leprechaun or rainbow and pot o’ gold — Make a sculpture of a magic Leprechaun, or a rainbow with customary pot of gold.
<i>March 10</i>	Pottery Painting Party —
