# **Director's Report:** Brandy McIntosh

- Teacher Appreciation scholarship
  - o to a teacher each year as a sign of appreciation
  - o mid-Willamette Valley but more rural school that has less resources
  - o process will begin with looking for a school
- Open studio passes discussion
  - Current passes are inconsistent and there have been complaints
  - Members take classes \$780 to have studio time rather than pay \$900 per year
  - Suggested prices
    - adult day passes \$12, \$6 For kids, Drop in Art \$3.00
    - adult monthly-\$60
    - 15 visit pass- \$125
    - 45 visit pass -\$360
    - Annual pass \$650

- Class price increase \$195.
  - Will allow instructors to be paid prep and clean up
- Drug and alcohol policy
  - Standard policy
  - o Important due to the potential for serious injury
  - o Gives management a policy to address instances of occupants under the influence
- Member request to have a retirement party, 15 to do Raku, more under parking cover for food
  - Board voted and passed motion to reopen parties closed during Covid
  - Cost from Fair board to use parking area needed
  - Timeline- before classes start in January
  - Studio will close during party
  - Brandy will meet with her and set detail and costs
- Scholarship policy
  - Member granted scholarship and asking for a second
    - Currently no rules as how many a year
    - Proposed motion to reinstate past policy of only one scholarship per year approved
    - 2<sup>nd</sup> scholarship for current request allowed as it was requested before policy put in place
- Non discrimination policy
  - Recently the approved language changed
    - Now it's on the basis of <u>actual or perceived</u> discrimination on the basis of color, religion, etc.,

- Owners are building a new building on McGilchrist that possibly could be built to suit that will be available 9-12 mos
- That gives time to find grants for the move
