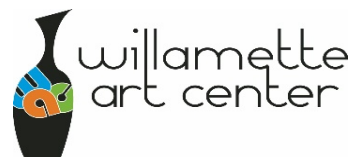


Willamette Art Center Fee Structure and Use Policy

Product/Activity	Cost	Notes
Adult Day Pass	\$12	This pass allows an adult patron to work in the studio on personal items during one business day. Instruction and clay not provided.
Children's Day Pass	\$6	This pass allows one child (age 16 & under) to work in the studio with an accompanying adult on personal items during one business day. Instruction and clay not provided.
Monday Gallery Paint Pass	\$3	Painting in the gallery held Monday 11am - 2pm, non-student price.
Adult Ceramics Class	8 week classes \$195 6 week summer classes \$165	Adult classes run 8 weeks (6 weeks in the summer) with one grace week added to complete any unfinished glazing. No new work may be started during that week. 25 lb of clay, instruction, and 10 firing tickets, and open studio during designated open studio hours included.
Adult Non-Ceramics	8 week classes \$195 6 week summer classes \$165	Adult classes run 8 weeks (6 weeks in the summer). Open studio (of the entire facility) is permitted during designated open studio hours. Additional fees may be charged for materials.
15 Visit Studio Pass	\$125	This pass entitles the patron to 15 days to work in the studio during designated open studio hours. Instruction and clay not provided. Pass may be split between 2 named patrons; both will be charged when both are present.
45 Visit Studio Pass	\$360	This pass entitles the patron to 45 days to work in the studio during designated open studio hours. Instruction and clay not provided. Pass may be split between 2 named patrons; both will be charged when both are present.
1 Month Pass	\$60	This pass entitles the patron 30 days of work from the date of purchase. Limited to designated open studio hours. Instruction and clay not provided. This pass can be used by one person and cannot be shared between 2 patrons.
Annual Pass	\$600	This pass entitles the patron to a full year of work from date of purchase. Limited to designated open studio hours. Instruction and clay not provided.
Family Clay Sunday NOT AVAILABLE		No registration is required. This allows families to participate in scheduled projects and to glaze previous projects. Children must be accompanied by an adult. Clay provided. Temporarily suspended on August 24, 2020 due to COVID-19 Restrictions.
Special Order Firings	Varies Full Kiln Prices	\$50 small kiln firing (818) / \$100 medium kiln firing (1027) \$150 large kiln firing (1227) / \$550 Bailey gas kiln firing / Susan \$300 gas kiln firing
Group Parties Semi Private Parties Private Lessons	\$150 first 6 people \$25 for each additional person	Participants receive instruction, materials, firing & glazing for one clay project. Add-ons may include raku or bisqueware (prices vary from \$5 - \$20). Scheduling and pre-registration required. \$50 non-refundable deposit required. Children must be accompanied by adults. Parties include space for food/cake/etc. Scheduled around WAC classes/events.
