

WAC Firing Policy

Firing at the WAC is based on a ticket system.

- 1 Yellow Ticket = \$2.00
- 1 Yellow Ticket pot = 6" wide and 6 " tall (approximately the size of an average cup)
- You can use the Size Chart to determine how many tickets you need to fire your piece.

Tickets are required to bisque fire:

- Can stack the pieces up to 6" = 1 ticket
- Put smaller pieces in a bowl = 1 ticket

Tickets are required to fire all glazed pots.

- Put small or stilted glazed pieces on a clay tray. Tray and stilts are returned to the owner.

You will receive:

- Class = 10 tickets to fire 10 pots measuring 6-inches cubed.
- Write your name on the back of your tickets. Put the ticket(s) in or under the pot. Place the pot on the cart to be fired.
- Bring your pots from home or make them in the studio. (Be sure to use cone 10 clay for high fire.)
- Tickets never expire. If you have leftovers, save them or share them with a friend.
- If you run out, you can purchase more for \$2 each.
- Policy begins **April 1, 2022**.

Please take white firing tickets that were purchased for \$1.00 to the front desk. Two white tickets can be exchanged for 1 yellow ticket. If you have further questions, please do not hesitate to ask Nikki, a monitor, or an instructor.
