CLASSES

Monday Handbuilding

In this class we start with two pinch pot balls and make sculptural pieces of art that will add a touch of whimsy to any home or garden. All experience levels welcome. Participants will need basic tools.

Monday Raku

The Raku class will focus on firing and surface decoration experimentation. Clay building demos and slips for surface decorations will enhance your work. Adding horsehair, feathers, copper and glass as alternatives or additives will make for unique work. Experience necessary.

Tuesday Daytime Handbuilding

Bird baths, totems, plant stakes, fountains, garden stones, flower vases and pots are just a few of the possibilities. One or two classes will include a hypertufa project.

Friday Paperclay Handbuilding

Want to expand your working ceramic vocabulary? Paperclay has endless possibilities. Cellulose fibers mixed with any clay harden, then are fired and glazed. This material pushes the ceramic boundaries. You will build in solid and slip clay. Other materials bond well and can be fired with the Paperclay. Wet clay bonds to bisque. Yes it's magic. It's functional and sculptural so you can let your creativity flow.
